Regular screenings help raise awareness of your child's development, making it easier to celebrate milestones and identify possible development concerns as early as possible.

Identifying delays early on allows experts to create individualized plans and perform the appropriate interventions that will improve a child's ability to thrive.

Screenings address both specific and general developmental areas, such as specific disorders like autism, specific areas like cognitive development, language, social-emotional development, and gross and fine motor skills, as well as more general, overall health and development.

Identifying a family's needs through the screening process creates the opportunity to provide Wyoming families with resources, services, and support.

Screenings are **FREE** in Wyoming and available in your county!
